

Policy Regarding Bulk Trash

Definitions

1. Rubble – Consists of rugs, clothing, furniture, TV's, wooden doors, old boards, and other household items. PICKUP – 1ST TUESDAY OF THE MONTH
2. Brush/Yard Waste – Consists of tree trimmings (not larger than 4" in diameter, 4' in length), brush, weeds/grass clippings, etc. PICKUP – 2ND TUESDAY OF THE MONTH
3. Metal – Consists of bicycles (tires removed), white goods (appliances), lawn mowers, lawn furniture, air conditioners, swings, etc. *There is a per item charge - \$2 per small item (grill, folding chair, etc.), \$4 per large item (appliances, etc.)* PICKUP – 3RD TUESDAY OF THE MONTH

These items must be separated and placed beside the alley, or in the place where your domestic trash is picked up, no earlier than 48 hours prior to the appropriate scheduled day. Property owners or tenants who place or leave trash indiscriminately on the alleyway or designated area that has not been scheduled for pick up may be charged with a Municipal Infraction and subject to a fine.

The following items are not permitted and will not be loaded on the truck:

- A. Paint cans containing paint (unless the paint has been allowed to dry and has hardened)
- B. Chemical cans or bags
- C. Tires* or tubes (property owners may dispose of 4 tires per month, off the rims, at the Hobbs Landfill at no charge – stickers are available at Caroline Co. Public Works 410-479-0520)
- D. Asbestos
- E. Stumps
- F. Tree trunks
- G. Hazardous material

Arrangements for disposal of these materials must be made with one of the following:

Waste from demolition, destruction, burning, or disposal of buildings, including shingles, bricks, cement blocks and plaster and any items weighing over 50 lbs. will not be picked up by town personnel and must be disposed of by the owner thereof. Special arrangements can be made with the town to dispose of these items using the town truck and paying the tipping fee or the items may be disposed of by making your own arrangements.

The volume of bulk trash which will be picked up by town personnel is limited to an amount that approximates a pickup truck load. Larger amounts can be disposed of by making arrangements with the Town to use the town truck, which the owner is responsible for loading. Town personnel will dispose of the trash at the appropriate landfill. The fee for this service is \$100 plus the associated landfill tipping fee. AGAIN – RUBBLE, METAL AND YARD WASTE CAN NOT BE MIXED.

**The Town may pick up annually in conjunction with the County's Tire Amnesty Program. This program is generally administered in the fall.*
