Reporting Violation of the Safe Drinking Water Act

Date of notice

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health and other standards. For the June through September 2009 monitoring period, we did not report the results for lead and copper by the tenth of the following month (October 10, 2009).*

Reporting was not completed as required for the following reason(s):

The Town of Ridgely was late receiving some of the samples back from the resident's who were selected to take part in the testing. The results were actually only a week late getting to MDE. All test results came back normal.
