COMMISSIONERS OF RIDGELY
CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. 2026-01

Notice is hereby given that the Commissioners of Ridgely adopted Charter Amendment Resolution No. 2026-01 during their regular meeting held on February 2, 2026.

Charter Amendment Resolution No. 2025-01 amends § 26 of the Charter of the Town of Ridgely to repeal outdated provisions pertaining to the appointment of a health officer, Town engineer, and street commissioner and to provide that the Town Attorney shall be a member of the Bar of the Supreme Court of Maryland. The foregoing constitutes a fair summary of Charter Amendment Resolution No. 2026-01.

Charter Amendment Resolution No. 2026-01 shall become and be considered a part of the Charter in all respects, to be effective and observed as such, on March 24, 2026, unless a petition for referendum meeting the requirements of Md. Code Ann., Local Gov't § 4-304(d) is either hand delivered or mailed via certified mail, return receipt requested and bearing a postmark from the U.S. Postal Service to the Commissioners of Ridgely, Attention: Stephanie L. Berkey, CMC, Clerk-Treasurer, 2 Central Avenue, Ridgely, Maryland, on or before Monday, March 16, 2026.
