The bids from Shore United Bank, Queenstown Bank and Provident State Bank for the construction loan of the Town Hall Renovation Project were opened and discussed. After review, Commissioner Casey made a motion to accept the bid from Provident State Bank, 2nd Commissioner Buckle, all in favor.

Debbie Pheil, KCI presented a Memorandum of Agreement with USDA and MSHPO for the Town Hall mitigation.
